### **Tasting Notes:**

Our Cellar Select Pinot is made by destemming only. We use hand cap punching to mix the lot, extract color, and flavor from the skins. When released **this wine is packed with solid fruit and spice character with a touch of oak toast on the aromatics. The aromatic profile on this wine is classic Pinot Noir.** It offers up plenty of dark fruit character with a generous mouth-feel and finish. It is well suited to a wide range of flavorful dishes.
